Stonecutters Island Sewage Treatment Works is one of the largest and compact sewage treatment works of its type in the world, occupying 10 hectares of reclaimed land. Stonecutters Island STW is designed to provide Chemically Enhanced Primary Treatment for an average flow of 1.7 million m³ per day. It was fully commissioned in December 2001. Its current inflow is about 1.4 million m³ per day.

During the visits, students had chance to visit the Main Central Room. The professional talked how the system work and share their work experience. Besides, the staff led the students look around the Stonecutters Island Sewage Treatment Works.
